## Beside the quote provided by Art and Display for the booth concept there are other costs associated with this effort. (Provided by Patrick Goranson, Art and Display)

"Normally, freight each way will be about \$1600...Round trip about \$3200. Installation / dismantle about \$2600. Since we have multiple shipments going, and we are going to be there anyway, we can bundle your freight and Installation/Dismantle through us for about \$4000 total rather than go through the normal channels.

Show services provided by Freeman or their subcontractors for items like Material Handling, Hanging Sign, booth cleaning, Electrical and Networking are in your show book.

I took a quick peek and the electrician rates seem reasonable \$50 per hour and each 8amp outlet \$71. My best guess there is about \$400 to \$500

Material Handling is through Freeman at \$74/cwt. I try to guess high on weight. If the booth plus carpet and padding, comes in at 3000 lb the MH cost would be \$2220.

Booth cleaning if they vacuum all 4 days \$960 Less if they do less days but you have a lot of white in your carpet.

Hanging sign to assemble and hang looks like about \$600.

Networking requires special password access so you may have to get that yourself."
