

Stanford/SLAC SC15 Floor Space Draft

Stanford University has been allocated a 20' x 30', floor location #2009, in the Austin Convention Center.

The attached draft diagram is not to scale. Phil Reese came up with the great idea of utilizing the Stanford (and SLAC) "S" as a shape for our space. We are aware this will not be as obvious from the floor but the symbolism would be really cool. The outline of the area is in the shape of the "S" used by Stanford University.

Notes:

- Stanford already has a ceiling sign (from Art and Display).
- The outer areas noted as "table for giveaways" (2) and the corner display "walls" (2) we thought would be good to rotate each day to sort of change the look of the area.
- The 3D/4K video monitor would be desirable because, as of now, the video that we expect to have will require those formats. For 3D we would need around 10 pair of 3D glasses paired with the monitor. It would be great if this technology was available in one nice sized monitor and rentable through you.
- We would like a small cabinet or table to accommodate a Blue Ray player.
- A couple of couches for a comfortable viewing/seating area.
- The top of the S would be a network area where people could sit and take advantage of the high speed WIFI or chat. Probably some content on the inside area too.
- The outer walls of the display corners and the "S" would be adorned with science and computing content.
- A small stowaway area for booth staff items. Lockable?
- If possible it would be nice to have some Cardinal red lighting to accent the area but not overwhelm it.

We look forward to hearing your thoughts and ideas. Please do not hesitate to call if you have questions or concerns. I wish I could give you an idea of our budget but this project is not currently funded and our hope is you can come up with two or three models for us to present to our management for budget purposes.
