Stanford/SLAC SC16 Floor Space Draft

Stanford University has allocated a 20' x 30'booth space, floor location #2101, in the Salt Palace Convention Center.

The attached draft diagram is not to scale. Utilizing the Stanford carpet again as a frame for our booth we came up with a different idea for this year.

Notes:

- Stanford already has a ceiling sign and "S" carpet.
- Rectangular wall area with openings on each side for access.
 - SciComp graphics on the outer walls. With the idea of having the tree graphic on the carpet continuing up the wall where the monitor is mounted.
 - The inner walls we would like to be "white board" surfaces to allow for writing with dry erase markers for collaboration.
 - o Two tables (a bit larger than last years) each with 3 chairs.
 - Storage area to lock away items.
- Flat screen monitor (4K/3D TBD) mounted on the outer wall (facing entrance).
- The remaining carpeted area will have a couch and two cubes (like last year) facing the monitor.
- Two kiosks at the entrance.

The budget has not yet been established but I would say that we are attempting to keep the costs down as much as possible while retaining a great presentation. Hopefully this draft design will align with that thinking. We look forward to working with you again and hearing your thoughts and ideas.
