Good fraction of attendees from underrepresented groups.



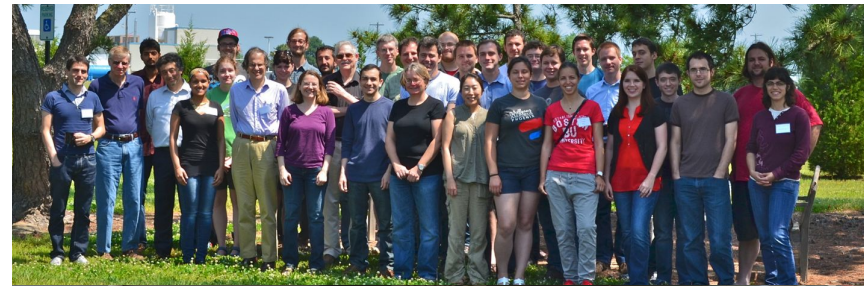
Fermi Summer School 2020
