Fermi Summer School COVID-19 Guidelines

Please refer to Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (<u>www.cdc.gov</u>) guidelines for information about <u>preventing the spread of COVID-19</u> and <u>what to do if you are sick</u>. We are counting on you to support precautions to prevent spread of the disease at the Fermi Summer School.

- A COVID-19 vaccination is not required to attend the Summer School, though both the CDC and the University of Delaware recommend remaining up-to-date with COVID-19 vaccination & boosters.
- Masks continue to be required based on CDC guidance for those who are experiencing symptoms, who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 10 days or who have been exposed to COVID-19 within the past 10 days.
- Please respect personal boundaries for social distancing and personal precautions such as mask wearing. Harassment of anyone about their choice of wearing a mask or not will not be tolerated.
- Testing is encouraged. Participants testing positive for COVID will need to isolate. University policy is to isolate for 5 days and to wear a mask for a further 5 days. Meals will be provided in rooms if a participant needs to isolate.
- Please follow good hygiene rules -- wash hands regularly and make use of hand sanitizer, avoid sharing personal items, cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue, and follow other good public health practices. If you feel sick or develop possible COVID symptoms, take a test as soon as possible.
