

SSHFS

- There exists a very easy way to mount a SLAC filesystem including NFS disks(!) on your home machine:
 - **SSHFS**
- An example:
 - **'twins' is my laptop, 'lat' is my SLAC desktop:**

```
twins::~/home/borgland> mkdir tmp/nsf_slac
twins::~/home/borgland> sshfs borgland@lat.slac.stanford.edu:/nfs/slac/g/cdms/u01/
                        /home/borgland/tmp/nsf_slac/
twins::~/home/borgland> cd tmp/nsf_slac/
twins::~/home/borgland/tmp/nsf_slac> ls *
CDMS_ImageNavigator data DetMC_data G4_data mcprod users
```

- My AFS home directory is mounted with:
 - **twins::~/home/borgland> sshfs borgland@lat.slac.stanford.edu:/u/ek/borgland/**
/home/borgland/tmp/Slac/
- It's also really fast even over my run-of-the-mill DSL line.
