



Difference in Daffodil and normal ping_data.pl form output

The Daffodil version of ping-data.pl <http://ping-data.pl> is unusual:

- Normally at the top of the ping_data.pl (e.g. http://pinger.unimas.my/cgi-bin/ping_data.pl) output form there are some boxes that appear at the top that help in diagnosing problems (see below).
- These appear to be missing in your the Daffodil version at http://203.190.11.4/cgi-bin/ping_data.pl

The two scripts say they are the same version (3.93).
