

# Editing Production Software

Use when you would like to make a change to software that the group maintains

## Step-by-step guide

Completing the [PyDM tutorial](#) is a strongly encouraged prerequisite

1. Find where it lives
  - a. The easiest way to do this is to find the program on launch pad, right click it > edit and see the file path
  - b. If it lives in ~/opsTools, continue down this list!
  - c. If it doesn't live in ~/opsTools, consider migrating it as a side project (it's a good exercise!), but otherwise exit this list and use the CVS workflow on the wiki
2. [Create a personal copy](#) where you can do all your work
